

Symbols and ASCII Codes for Phonetic Transcription in French

Note: The symbols used for French nasal vowels are not those traditionally used in the International Phonetic Alphabet. This adaptation has been made due to the limitations of Lucidia Sans Unicode font. To produce a symbol, hold down **Alt** while typing the code on the numeric keypad (**NumLock** "on").
