UNT has broadened its Hebrew Language Program to include **BIBLICAL HEBREW**, the original language of the Old Testament, also known as the Hebrew Bible. Beginning this fall, the two-year Hebrew sequence, offered by the Department of Foreign Languages and Literatures in cooperation with the Jewish Studies Program, will focus on the language of the Bible. Students will read and understand the Hebrew Bible, and also learn the basics of Hebrew as it is spoken today in Israel.

The two-year Hebrew sequence can be used for foreign language requirements. Credits also can be applied to the **Jewish Studies minor**. Students also can augment their UNT Hebrew courses with **Study Abroad programs in Israel**.
